

IRA BENEFICIARY DESIGNATION FORM

Use this form to indicate the person or persons to whom your retirement plan assets should be paid in the event of your death. If you are not survived by a validly designated beneficiary, your benefits will be paid to your estate. The beneficiaries named on this form and the percentage of distribution may be changed or revoked at any time by completing a new Beneficiary Designation Form. This designation revokes any previous one you may have filed with the Funds, its transfer agent or the custodian of your IRA and will become effective only upon receipt by the transfer agent as agent for the custodian.
